The coach will be part of the selection panel which will be appointed by the Masters Board. The Coach should co-operatively see that every team member is motivated to perform at 100% effort at all times. **This is not a player coach role (but if a suitable standalone coach can't be found the board would consider a player coach)**

**Responsibilities:**

The team coach has the responsibility for the teams playing and results on the field  
The appointee will be expected to provide a strong leadership role to ensure that the fitness and skills of the players are met to the satisfaction of Indoor Cricket Masters New Zealand

**General Responsibilities include:**

- 1/. Ensuring that all members of the team play within the spirit of the game.
- 2/. Develop players knowledge of expectations of playing representative indoor cricket.
- 3/. Ensure the team upholds the highest level of conduct at all times in line with the code of conduct signed.
- 4/. Managing the "on-field" activities of the team.
- 5/. Ensure all players are at agreed fitness levels.
- 6/. Develop a game plan and communicate effectively the plan to the team.
- 7/. Liaison with the team's manager on all travel plans and activities
- 8/. Co-ordinate team activities and dress codes in association with the team manager:

- Practise sessions
- Meeting times
- Playing and Formal Uniforms to be at their highest standard at all times
- 9/. Representing Indoor Cricket Masters at all event Functions (as invited).
- 10/. Reporting requirements following the tournament, as outlined by ICNZ Masters
